Senator Lynn Boylan, Sinn Féin Spokesperson on Climate Justice (and ex-student of BCFE), will visit Ballyfermot Library on March 11th from 11-12 to speak on themes of climate, justice and sustainability. This event is organised as a collaboration between BCFE and the library.

Senator Lynn Boylan is also the Seanad spokesperson for Communications, Climate Action and Environment, Social Protection and Employment Affairs. Lynn grew up in Tallaght, Dublin. At the age of 12 Lynn's first act of political activism was to write to the Evening Herald supporting the Dublin Bus strikers. Lynn studied journalism at BCFE before going on to obtain qualifications in Environmental Resource Management, Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Conservation Management. In Ireland's 2014 European Election, Lynn topped the polls with 83,000 first preference votes. She was elected to the Seanad in 2020.

Author of many best-selling books including 'The Complete Field Guide to Ireland's Birds', 'Finding Birds in Ireland' and his memoir 'Don't Die in Autumn', Eric is also the co-author, photographer and editor of 'Ireland's Wildlife Year', a photographic journey through the Irish seasons. Eric's lifelong aim has been to bring an awareness and instil a love for Ireland's natural world.
